As one of the UoC's Research Centers, C-SEB aims to increase the international visibility of the UoC and networking opportunities for C-SEB researchers.

Information on C-SEB NETWORKING OPPORTUNITIES

To promote scientific exchange and to initiate or expand international research collaborations, C-SEB invites applications for the C-SEB International Fellowship Program:

The C-SEB International Fellowship Program offers funding of up to 6,000 € for C-SEB members to invite researchers from abroad to C-SEB and the UoC for research stays of varying lengths (up to 6 months).

Eligibility and requirements

Any C-SEB member employed at or receiving a stipend from the UoC can act as host and propose candidates. Eligible candidates are junior and senior researchers from institutions abroad who are strongly connected to C-SEB or work in a field related to C-SEB's overall topics.

Application and selection procedure

Decisive criteria for the granting of funds are the expected outcomes of the research stay with regard to its scientific

contribution to C–SEB as well as the promotion of international collaborations and of the international visibility of C–SEB and the UoC. The C–SEB Executive Board selects among the duly received proposals. The application deadline is $April \ 30^{th}$, 2024.

To suggest a candidate for the C-SEB International Fellowship Program, the hosting C-SEB member submits the <u>application form</u> along with a statement of purpose of the research stay, a confirmation letter from the guest, and the CVs of all researchers involved in a single PDF file to <u>c-seb@uni-koeln.de</u>. Applications are limited to 2 pages for the statement of purpose, 1 page for the confirmation letter, and 2 pages for each CV.
