

The Center for Social and Economic Behavior (C-SEB) at the University of Cologne (UoC) brings together researchers from economics, management science, and psychology to investigate the mechanisms that determine social and economic behavior. As one of the UoC's Research Centers, C-SEB aims to promote outstanding individuals and excellent research projects in the field of behavioral economics and social cognition.

## Information on C-SEB STUDENT AWARDS

To strengthen the link between research and teaching and to encourage the pursuit of an academic career, C-SEB invites nominations for C-SEB Student Awards aiming to honor excellent master students for their overall academic achievements.

Competition for the award is tied to a master thesis in economic and/or psychological research that relates to C-SEB's overall topics. Students with <u>master theses</u> <u>submitted</u> between November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023 and April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024 or with <u>proposals for planned master theses</u> are eligible.

All master students can be nominated who are/were enrolled as students at the UoC for their master thesis and whose master thesis supervisor is a member of the **Faculty of Management, Economics and Social Sciences** or the **Faculty of Human Sciences**. Any supervisor can nominate only one student per round.

The C-SEB Student Award is a recognition of exceptionally promising students. In addition to the award, up to  $2,000 \in$  can be made available for carrying out the master thesis project itself or for research directly building on the results of a completed master thesis.

Financial means can be granted for as long as the award winners (1) are themselves members of the UoC (student/ employee/ stipend holder), or (2) conduct the research

in collaboration with a researcher who is employed at or receives a stipend from the UoC.

Decisive criteria for the award are the overall academic excellence of the student as well as the scientific quality and originality of the master thesis project. The C-SEB Executive Board selects among the duly received nominations. The nomination deadline is **April 30**<sup>th</sup>, **2024**.

Please submit the <u>nomination form</u> along with a description of the completed and/or planned research, the student's CV, the student's current transcript of records, and a laudation by the supervisor (covering the student's overall academic achievements and the scientific contribution of the master thesis project) in a single PDF file to <u>c-seb@uni-koeln.de</u>.

Applications are limited to 1 page for the description of the master thesis project (plus references), 1 page for the description of research building on a completed master thesis (if applicable, plus references), 1 page for the CV, and 1 page for the laudation.
